There was a water leak on Main St that was repaired. Discussion of needing to replace water lines replacing 500ft. at a time (unsure if it is one time per year) does not require engineering and would save on the cost.

Karson would like to get some more fittings to have on hand for when there are water leaks. He is going to purchase parts to repair the Penn Valley Pump.
